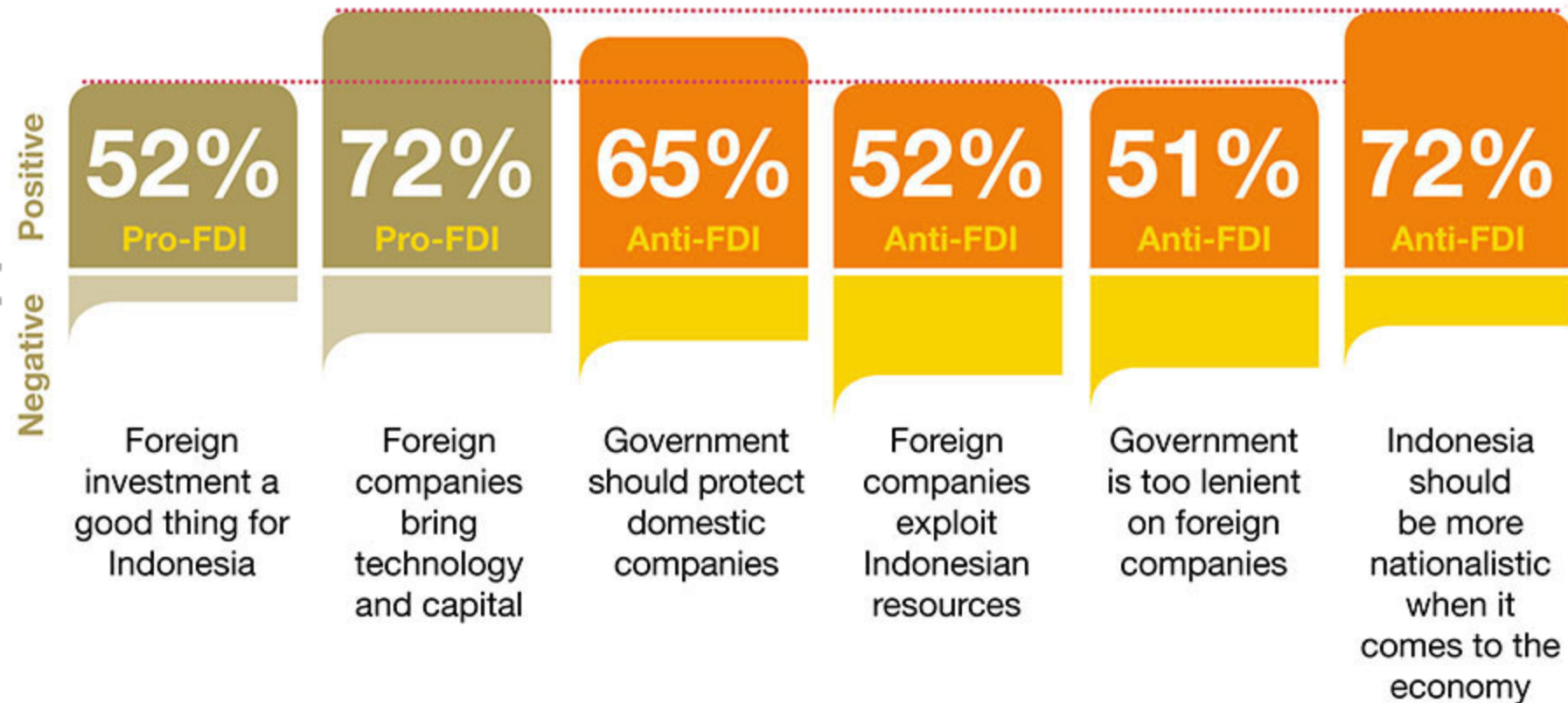


Ambiguity about Foreign Investment



The young people surveyed seemed to hold conflicting attitudes about foreign investment. Although a slight majority believes that foreign investment is a good thing (52%), similar majorities felt that foreign companies exploit Indonesian resources and that the government was being too lenient towards foreign companies. Likewise, a strong majority of respondents (72%) acknowledged the fact that foreign companies bring technology and capital while the same percentage of young people felt that Indonesia should be more nationalistic.
